The first question we, as Christians, must ask and answer is, "Should I be involved in politics or politically charged issues?" "After all," so the thinking goes, "as a Christian I need to remain above politics and focus on the spiritual'. This brings to mind a statement I heard many years ago, that so-and-so "was too heavenly minded to be of any earthly good."

Yes, as Christians we are citizens of heaven, but the truth is that God has placed each one of us in our country as a citizen of that nation. With that privilege comes certain rights, but also definite responsibilities as a citizen. We may think we can remain unstained by politics, but the reality is that virtually everything today has been, is, and will be affected by politics – as long as man is in charge of governments, and that charge is by God's design. Politics has infiltrated not just government, but entertainment, finance, sports, business, education, leisure, even taking a walk in a park.

What if our Founding Fathers believed they should not have involved themselves with politics? Where then would be the United States? In the summer of 1787 when there was much debate concerning the Constitution of our newly won independent Nation, Benjamin Franklin rose in Congress and spoke these memorable words:

"The longer I live, the more convincing proofs I see of this truth, that God governs in the affairs of men. And if a sparrow cannot fall to the ground without His notice, is it probable that an empire can rise without His aid? We have been assured, sir, in our Sacred writings that 'except the Lord build the house, they labor in vain that build it.' I firmly believe this; and I also believe that without His concurring aid we shall succeed in this political building no better than the builders of Babel; We shall be divided...our projects will be confounded. And what is worse, mankind may hereafter...despair of establishing Government by human wisdom and leave it to chance, war or conquest." (In God We Still Trust by Dr. Richard G. Lee, page 206)

As a result, Congress instituted prayer before every session.

One more thought to ponder from Benjamin Rush:

"Without [religion] there can be no virtue, and without virtue there can be no liberty, and liberty is the object and life of all republican governments." (In God We Still Trust by Dr. Richard G. Lee, page 189)

The truth and reality of this world is that those who vote and make their voices heard shape the culture and values of that nation. If Christians do not use our voice, our influence and our vote to stand for truth, virtue and what is right, we forfeit the task of government (politics) to those who hold God in ill-regard, or worse yet, despise God and work tirelessly to impose their unbiblical view and their ungodly belief of the man-defined rights they will bestow on us, not the rights and liberties bestowed by God.

Are we really willing to give away without cost or struggle what so many before us sacrificed their blood and lives to protect and pass on?

A second question to be asked and answered is of greater import: "Who's opinion matters more, my opinion or God's?" If we are, in fact, surrendered to Jesus, our opinion matters not. What matters is what God tells us is true (Scriptural). Either God is wholly true and His Word wholly perfect, or we can believe none of it. How can any part of it be considered untrue or no longer relevant (in our opinion) and not question if other parts can be trusted (in our opinion)?

As a true believer in Christ, we must search the Scriptures to find out God's opinion, His truth; it is wrong and dangerous to distort truth of Scripture to fit our beliefs. Isaiah 55:8 is worth remembering, "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways," declares the Lord. Further, 2 Timothy 4:3-4 cautions us, "For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but wanting to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance with their own desires, and will turn away their ears from the truth and will turn aside to myths." Then ask God what should I be doing in light of this scripture? Surely God would say you are to be salt and light.

Rationalizing is the first sign of compromising with the truth and rationalizing our vote to be contrary to God's perspective is treading on dangerous ground. Jesus Himself said "He who is not with Me, is against Me" (Matt 12:30a).

If we hold ourselves to be people of the Truth, we can no longer "go along to get along" if it compromises with the Truth. We Christians, are the Called for such a time as this!

Do not take what we say as the truth; research scripture and decide for yourself, only after asking the Lord, "What are Your thoughts? What are Your ways?" There is no changing or shifting shadow with God; He could not be a Holy God were His Word to change and adapt "with the times".

Neither can we take the word of any man, be they pastor or politician, good friend or media personality, influencer or celebrity, scholar or neighbor. We must test everything we hear and think against Scripture and align our thoughts and ways to God, not the other way round. Sadly, there are altogether too many so-called Pastors, Teachers, and even plain old Christians who do not know the truth, nor seem to be inclined to be willing to understand the truth of God's heart and His beliefs.

Below are various political and social issues argued and discussed around water coolers (do they still exist), on busses, throughout social media (is it really social) and over meals and drinks world-wide. There is no attempt here to tell you what to think, nor for whom to vote, but it is a rather meant to be a start for your own journey into God's Word and, more importantly into His heart, regarding matters of great consequence in our country today.

As a caution, remember that Scripture is not a single verse in a vacuum; Scripture always corroborates Scripture, and context matters. Very rarely, if at all, will there be a Lone Ranger scripture with no Tonto to back it up. Search for them. You may just find it to be fun and enlightening.

The goal is NOT to make this process too easy for you – for each topic some Scriptures are provided in full for your quick reading and understanding; other scriptures are provided as additional references for your reading and studying. All of these are presented to try to help you see God's heart on these topics. There are undoubtedly others – find them, discuss them and pass them on to others trying to search out the truth. Our convictions must be based on what we learn and know of God's heart, not what we are told.

Once you understand God's heart and truth, that is not the end. James 2:17 says "...faith, if it has no works, is dead..." <u>At a minimum, we each need to vote based on</u> <u>His standard of right and wrong, not our opinion.</u> To not vote is unbiblical and we will all be held to account for what we did with what God put before us. We need to see the fruit of the politician and not just what they say. Know them by their fruit.

No candidate or party is perfect, but we can and must vote for the candidate which is most closely aligned with God's heart and truth. To be sure, not every issue has a specific verse or verses which address it. Where those situations exist, we should use our understanding of God's heart and standard of righteousness, gained through prayer and reading of His word, to make the best godly decision we can. James 1:5 says, "but if any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all generously and without reproach, and it will be given to him".

One last question: If the position we take or support has no Scriptural basis, should we be supporting it? The question is not whether God is on our side, but rather, whether we are on God's side of each issue. Know what you believe, and why you believe it - based on Scripture, not man's opinion.

Happy learning, but...

One last consideration: now that you have your possibly new-found Biblical understanding of God's heart, how do you share that with others? As Ephesians 4:14-15 says, "as a result, we are no longer to be children, tossed here and there by waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, by craftiness in deceitful scheming; but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all aspects into Him who is the head, even Christ"

- **Proverbs 14:15-16** The naive believe everything, but a sensible man considers his steps. A wise man is cautious and turns away from evil, but a fool is arrogant and careless.
- **1 John 4:1** Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world.
- **Proverbs 1:7** The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, fools despise wisdom and instruction.

- **Psalm 119:130** The unfolding of Your Word gives light; it gives understanding to the simple.
